Dear Mr. Fulkerson and Ms. Brookins:

Under the authority delegated to me by Governor Tony Evers, I am hereby approving the Janesville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization's amendment to the 2023-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Janesville urbanized area. The amendment was approved and adopted by the Janesville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Board on February 13, 2023. We will reflect by reference the 2023-2026 federal aid projects covered by this approval in our 2023-2026 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

Copies of the TIP Amendment and Resolution Number 2023-01 for the Janesville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization are enclosed. This TIP amendment represents a comprehensive, continuous, and cooperative effort between the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), local communities, affected transit operators, and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), and is designed to meet the objectives of Title 23 USC 134 and 135 and their implementing regulations 23 CFR 450 and the MPO regional transportation system plan.

We have determined that the proposed amendment: 1) is consistent with the adopted MPO regional transportation system plan, 2) conforms to this state's approved implementation plan under the federal Clean Air Act and 42 U.S.C. 7504, 7506 (c) and (d) and 40 CFR 93 (23 CFR 450.222(a)(7), and 3) ensures that the TIP remains fiscally constrained in that federal funding resources are sufficient to support the new or modified projects.

**A Resolution Endorsing Amendments to the 2023-2028 Transportation Improvement Program for the Janesville Metropolitan Planning Area**

**WHEREAS**, the Janesville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Board is recognized by the Governor of Wisconsin, the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration as the urban transportation planning policy body with responsibility for carrying out the urban transportation planning process in accordance with federal regulations.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Policy Board of the Janesville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization endorses the following amendments to the *2023-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)* for the Janesville urbanized area as adopted on October 24, 2022, as being consistent with the Janesville Area *2020-2050 Long Range Transportation Plan*.


1. *TIP ID – 371-23-T02. FTA Section 5307 Farebox Replacement funding to the Janesville Transit System.*
2. *TIP ID – 371-23-ED04. FTA Section 5310 Vehicle Replacement funding to Aptiv, Inc. for the replacement of one transit bariatric van.*
3. *Incorporation of 2023-2025 targets for the Pavement and Bridge Performance Measures (PM2) and System performance, Freight and CMAQ Performance Measures (PM3)*
4. *Incorporation of Public Transit Agency Safety Plan (PTASP) targets for CY2023.*
5. *TIP ID – 371-23-001. STBG-FLX Center Avenue Railroad Crossing (UP Crossing 177423R) funding to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation.*

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Policy Board certifies that the requirements of Section 134 of Title 23, CFR 450 (the Federal Transit Administration's and Federal Highway Administration's regulations for urban transportation planning), Title VI of the *Civil Rights Act* of 1964 and the Title VI assurance executed by the State of Wisconsin under 23 U.S.C. 140 and 29 U.S.C. 794, the *Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act* (P.L. 114-94), and all applicable ADA requirements are met.

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Janesville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Board approves these amendments to the *2023-2028 Transportation Improvement Program*.
