Before a permit to do blasting as required under section 12.3a(3) Fire Prevention Code shall be issued, the applicant for such permit shall file a bond deemed adequate in each case by the Bureau of Fire Prevention, which bond shall become available for the payment of any damages arising from the permitted blasting.

Permits required by Section 12.3a(1) Fire Prevention Code shall not be issued for:

1. Liquid nitroglycerin.
2. Dynamite (except gelatin dynamite) containing over 60% of liquid explosive ingredients.
3. Dynamite having an unsatisfactory absorbent or one that permits leakage of a liquid explosive ingredient under any conditions liable to exist during storage.
4. Nitrocellulose in a dry and uncompressed condition in quantity greater than ten pounds net weight in one package.
5. Fulminate of mercury in a dry condition and fulminate of all other metals in any condition except as a component of manufactured articles not hereinafter forbidden.
6. Explosive compositions that ignite spontaneously or undergo marked decomposition, rendering the products or their use more hazardous, when subjected to forty-eight consecutive hours or less at a temperature of 167 degrees Fahrenheit.
7. New explosives until approved by the U.S. Department of Transportation, except that permits may be issued to educational, governmental or industrial laboratories for instructional or research purposes.
8. Explosives condemned by the U.S. Department of Transportation.
9. Explosives not packed or marked in accordance with the requirements of the Department of Transportation.
10. Explosives containing an ammonium salt and a chlorate.
