Accessibility

All buses operated by JTS are equipped to be accessible to persons with disabilities. Features include a "kneeling" device that lowers the front step of the bus closer to the ground. Riders in wheelchairs or other mobility devices who cannot climb the steps will find all JTS buses are equipped with ramps. Disabled persons and senior citizens are welcome to use the priority seating at the front of each bus.

Non-Discrimination Notices

All routes, services, and accommodations on JTS are offered without regard to race, color, or national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. 
