EXACT FARE, TOKEN AND PASS SALES

JTS requires customers pay the exact fare when boarding a JTS bus. Customers do not receive change on board from drivers when purchasing a ride or fare materials. Riders must have the exact fare ready to give the driver or deposit in the fare box. There is a change machine located in the waiting room at the Transfer Center for added convenience.

TRANSFERS

One immediate transfer per passenger is free and shall be requested upon boarding. Transfers are only valid for the time and day shown. They cannot be used to return on the same route, and must be handed to the driver when the transfer is made.

JTS will make every reasonable effort to ensure your transfer is made. Transfer connections are **NOT** guaranteed as schedules may vary due to weather and traffic conditions.

SPECIAL FARE PROGRAMS

JTS offers special fare programs tailored to the needs of students and other specific groups. These programs are administered by employers, community service organizations, and the school district; who determine program eligibility and sell or distribute the special fare tokens or passes. For information on these programs, please contact the sponsoring agencies.

HOURS AND DAYS OF SERVICE

JTS buses operate each weekday between 6:15 am and 10:15 pm. On Saturdays, buses run from 8:45 am to 6:15 pm. Buses do not run on Sundays or on the following holidays:

- Thanksgiving Day
- Independence Day
- Christmas Day

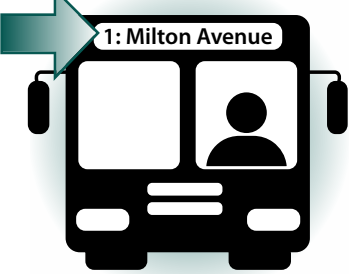
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SERVICES FOR RIDERS WITH DISABILITIES

NOTICE: Video and audio recording systems are in use at the Transfer Center and on JTS buses. Images and audio recorded by these systems may be used to identify and prosecute offenders.

HOW TO IDENTIFY YOUR BUS

The name and number of each bus route is displayed on a large sign above the windshield of every bus. The route name is also displayed above the first passenger window just behind the front door.



HOW TO BOARD

JTS has marked bus stops along all of its routes. To board, simply walk to the nearest street where a route operates, and stand at the closest Bus Stop sign.

HOW TO EXIT THE BUS



When the bus is about one block from your destination, signal the driver by pulling the bell cord once. Wait for the bus to come to a complete stop before moving to the exit. Please exit through the rear door whenever possible. Wait for the green lights to come on, then push the yellow vertical touch strip to open the door. Please watch your step, and move directly away from the bus. Never walk along the side of the bus, and wait

until the bus has pulled away before crossing the street. If you need to have the front step lowered, go to the front door, and ask the driver to lower the bus.

WHILE YOU ARE ON THE BUS

Please observe the following rules so that all passengers may have a pleasant ride in a clean, safe bus:

- Strollers, shopping carts, etc. **must** be kept out of aisle. Children may not ride in strollers while the bus is moving.
- Small children **must** remain seated next to or on the lap of a responsible adult at all times while on the bus.
- No electronic cigarettes, smoking, vaping or chewing tobacco while on the bus.

- Remain seated and avoid moving around inside when the bus is moving.
- If all seats are full and you must stand, move as far back in the bus as possible so that others may board easily. Hold onto a handrail when standing. Never ride in the doorways of the bus.
- Loud or vulgar language and rough housing is never allowed. Violators may be asked to leave the bus.
- Please occupy only one seat, and do not put your feet on the seat.
- Health regulations require that shoes and shirts be worn at all times.
- Avoid long conversations with the driver as this distracts his or her attention from providing you with a safe ride.
- Car batteries, gasoline cans, propane tanks, and oxygen tanks other than small tanks meant for personal medical use, are not allowed on board.
- Weapons of any kind may not be brought on board.
- Do not play electronic devices without headphones.
- Don't throw trash on the floor. Each bus is equipped with a waste can near the front door.
- Please do not eat or drink.

EXTRA SERVICE ROUTES

During times of peak demand, JTS operates additional service on a number of routes. Extra Service routes are open to anyone, run during the morning and afternoon rush hours. JTS Extra Service schedules are available wherever JTS literature may be found for additional information.

JTS Bike On Bus Program

With a bike rack on many of our buses, you can make bike riding part of your regular commute! In order to bike 'n' ride, you must have a Bike on Bus certification. There is no cost or expiration. In order to be certified, individuals must be age 11 and older and must complete a brief training session. To set up an appointment for this training, call the JTS office at 755-3150.

ACCESSIBILITY FEATURES

All buses operated by JTS are equipped to be accessible to persons with disabilities. Features include a “kneeling” device that lowers the front step of the bus closer to the ground. Riders in wheelchairs or other mobility devices who cannot climb the steps will find all JTS buses are equipped with ramps. Persons with disabilities and senior citizens are welcome to use the priority seating at the front of each bus. Buses also include automatic visual and audible announcement of popular bus stops; points of interest; major intersections and transfer points along the route.

BOARDING WITH A MOBILITY DEVICE

If you use a mobility aid and can get to a bus stop, you can enjoy all the convenience of regularly scheduled JTS routes. Be sure to check the bus schedule and be at the appropriate bus stop a few minutes early. When the bus arrives, your JTS driver will operate the ramp and instruct you as to how to board and exit. The driver will also assist you in securing your mobility device. There is no additional charge for this service. If you have a question about JTS accessibility features, the types of mobility devices we can accommodate, or to arrange a personal training session call 755-3150.

PARATRANSIT SERVICE

Disabled individuals who are not able to travel to a bus stop from their home, from the bus stop to their destination, or who require more assistance in using transit than can be given by a driver deploying a wheelchair ramp, may qualify for paratransit service. “Dial-A-Ride” service operates on an advanced reservation basis. Reservations must be made the day before transportation is needed. It is available during the same hours as regular JTS bus service is operated. The basic cash fare for paratransit service is twice the regular fare.

In order to use this service you must apply for certification through JTS. Call JTS at 755-3150 for more details on this special service, to request an application, or to request to use the service as a visitor. Applications may also be downloaded at our web site. Once certified, disabled individuals may make reservations for transportation or obtain additional information by calling Rock County Transit at 757-5054. TDY users can call 757-5226.

Evening service for passengers certified as “ADA Eligible” is provided by buses operating the JTS Nightside service. Call JTS for details.

IDENTIFICATION CARDS

Senior Citizens, Individuals with disabilities, and Federal Medicare cardholders can ride JTS buses at reduced rates with their Medicare or special identification card. Special IDs cards are available at these locations:

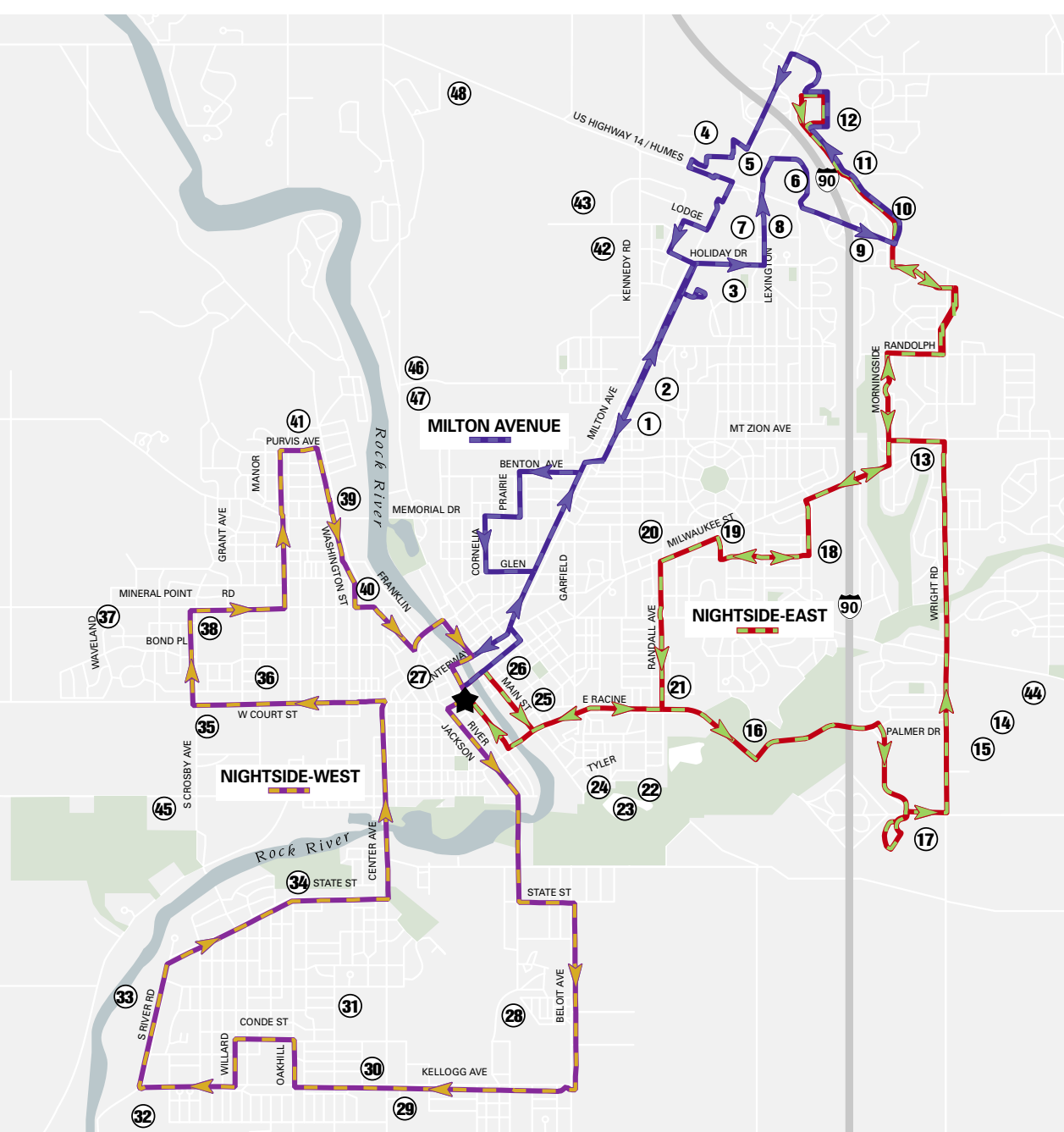

Medicare or Special IDs must be shown every time when purchasing or using a reduced fare pass, token, or cash fare.

JTS also honors valid reduced fare or paratransit certification cards from any US transit system when presented at the time the fare is paid or paratransit service is provided.

VISUAL AND HEARING IMPAIRMENTS

Riders with visual impairments may receive information on JTS services by calling 755-3150, or by picking up a large print guide. Our buses are equipped with Automated Voice Announcement (AVA). The AVA announces route names, major stops, transfer points. Upon request the Driver will announce specific stops. Hearing impaired persons may request JTS information through the City of Janesville TDY line at 755-3190 from 7:30 am to 4:30 pm Monday through Friday. JTS buses are equipped with speakers and lighted “Stop Requested” signs to help hearing impaired passengers find the correct stop. Drivers will provide assistance as needed.

JANESVILLE NIGHTSIDE SERVICE

JTS' Nightside goes where you need and want to go in Janesville. Nightside routes cover the City once each hour beginning at 6:15 PM, and you can transfer from route-to-route to get where you need to go. Our downtown Transfer Center is open for your convenience until 10:00 PM. The dispatcher is on duty during the evening hours to assist you in using the Nightside service and selling tokens and passes. Nightside service operates as “Route Deviation”, which allows the bus driver to go up to ¾ mile off the published route to make pickups or drop offs. To request a pickup that is a deviation from the regular route call 608-755-3150. To request a drop off that is a deviation ask the driver when you board the bus. Nightside and daytime fares are the same, but please remember drivers do not sell tokens or passes during Nightside. Tokens and monthly passes are welcome; however, All Around Town day passes are not valid after 6:15 PM.

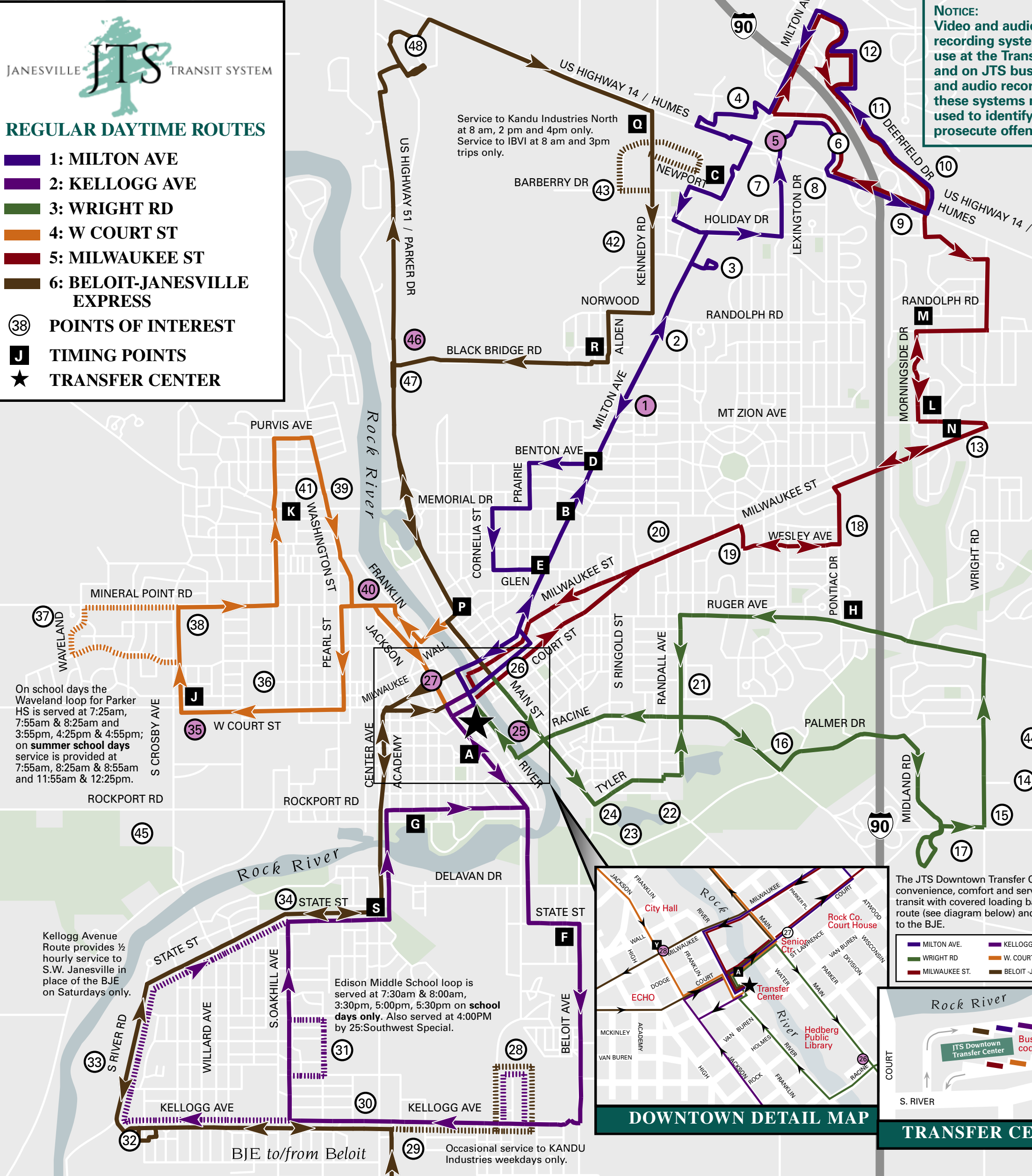

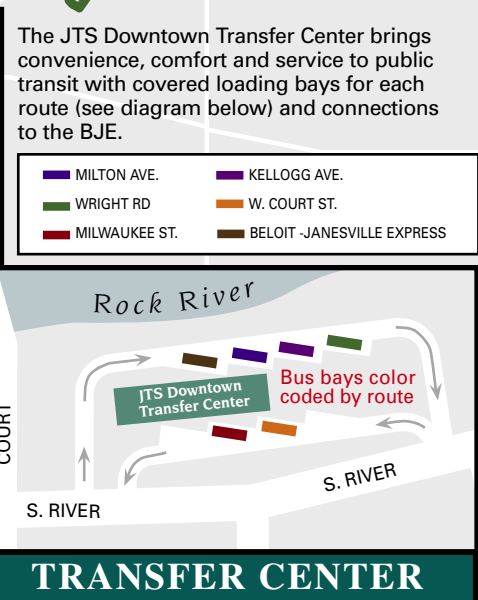

6: БЕЛОИТ-ЖАНЕСВИЛЛЕ EXPRESS

The Janesville Transit System and the Beloit Transit System jointly operate service between the two cities year round Monday through Friday, except holidays. The route runs between the Beloit Transfer Center, through the JTS Downtown Transfer Center and extends to Highway 14 north of Janesville. Stops are made at all locations along the route, as well as at the Rock County Job Center, UWW at Rock County, Blackhawk Technical College (BTC), Rock Valley Community Programs (RVCP), the Rock County Institutions, Kandu Industries North (occasional service), IBVI (occasional service) and Arrow Park. The route also connects with both Beloit Transit and JTS local routes.
